Evidence of professional collaboration in Scotland

We are writing to highlight some work undertaken in Scotland which we believe demonstrates positive collaboration between the pharmacy professions.

Our Pharmacy 2030 vision was co-produced and co-published by our two organisations. It describes a professional vision for all of pharmacy in Scotland.

The development of the vision was based on collaboration. We sought views from every part of pharmacy and from non-pharmacy stakeholders through surveys, focus groups, meetings and three consultation periods on drafts.

We attach copies of the full vision and an executive summary which were published in February 2022. We hope you can see from the content and from the language we use, that this is a vision which demonstrates our mutual respect for each other's profession and our commitment to collaborative professional leadership.
