Description	<p>The Commonwealth Pharmacists Association are expanding their <a href="#">Commonwealth Partnerships for AMS programme</a>, building on the successful African/UK health partnerships established through phase 1.</p> <p>Traditionally, these types of grants are awarded to medical and nursing staff, and in this case of the funding hosted by CPA, funding will only be awarded to applicants who demonstrate pharmacists being in leadership roles within the proposed projects.</p> <p>A call will be going out to UK pharmacists to submit an application for projects to form part of this phase 2 of the programme.</p>
